Clean Cooking Madagascar is an NGO promoting clean renewable energy to households in Madagascar. The primary role is to promote and support the expansion of the Madagascar Ethanol Stove Program and to ensure that all parties involved in this program comply with the program requirements to ensure the highest quality of all aspects of this program. The goal of this program is to have 100,000 ethanol stoves distributed to households in Madagascar by 2020. These are cost effective initiatives that will ensure A BETTER LIVING for households in Madagascar while at the same time have a great development value for Madagascar as a whole.



CCM is hiring a consultant to train sugarcane growers

Madagascar Ethanol Stove Program is now looking for an organization that can provide support to sugarcane producers in order to insure a sustainable sugarcane production. Those sugarcane producers will insure the sugarcane supply to micro distilleries partners of the Madagascar Ethanol Stove Program. As a reminder, sugarcane is the main feedstock used by micro distilleries to produce ethanol, even though other feedstocks are used by some distilleries. The assignment of this entity

will be based on annual contract, that might be renewed annually for up to five years as long as the provided support meet the expectations of Clean Cooking Madagascar. Tender request for a pilot micro distillery

Clean Cooking Madagascar will be setting up in Madagascar a pilot micro-distillery in early 2017. This pilot micro-distillery will be set up as a joint venture with a potential partner who will be sharing the income from this micro-distillery during the first five years. After these five years, the partner will be able to buy this pilot micro-distillery at a lower price, according to a contract signed by both parties. Preliminary shortlist of the five candidates have been registered among the twelve received applications, after having published a request for expression of interest

for this partnership. Price of sugarcane is the key criteria, all shortlisted prospects could provide sugarcane at a price of AR 50.000 per ton or less. SAFI MADAGASCAR, UP and RUNNING

After launching the first SAFI single burner stoves in August 2016, around 800 stoves have been sold in Madagascar. Fuel supply has been a challenge, but SAFI expects fuel supply from more suppliers in order to improve soon. SAFI has ordered more stoves from producer and these stoves are now on the way to Madagascar. Any Local Project Implementation Partner will hence be able to buy stoves from SAFI by the end of 2016.

The European Union organized a seminar on sugarcane production which is held from November 29th to 1ST December 2016. Clean Cooking Madagascar was not made aware of this event, hence it was not listed in previous newsletters.

Clean Cookstoves will be soon available in Malagasy Market

After registering the five best candidates, site visits with Wildlife Conservation Society will be conducted in early December.
