The goal of this program is to have 100,000 ethanol stoves distributed to households in Madagascar by 2020. These are cost effective initiatives that will ensure A BETTER LIVING for households in Madagascar while at the same time have a great development value for Madagascar as a whole.


MALAGASY LUTHERAN CHURCH: IN THE PROCESS OF SETTING UP A PILOT MICRO-DISTILLERY IN THE SOUTH OF MADAGASCAR

The Malagasy Lutheran Church also known as Fiangonana Loterana Malagasy is now in the process of setting up a micro-distillery of a capacity of 5000 liters a day in Antsirabe. This micro-distillery will be a pilot one since they plan to set up more micro-distilleries in Madagascar. Sugarcane and cassava will be the main feedstocks used for this pilot micro-distillery. This micro-distillery was built in October and the Malagasy Lutheran Church plans to make it operational in May 2017.

ETHANOLA WILL SOON DISTRIBUTE 2500 SINGLE BURNER STOVES IN THE NORTH OF MADAGASCAR

After having signed a partnership contract with Clean Cooking Madagascar, Ethanola which headquarter is based in South Africa, is now working day and night to distribute ethanol stoves and ethanol in the North of Madagascar. Their plan is to start distributing single burner stoves in April by working closely with five different churches to help them distribute their stoves. In fact, their stoves are imported but assembled here in Madagascar. Note that single burner stoves will be soon available in Malagasy market in April. Ethanola plans to distribute around 2500 stoves in the North of Madagascar.

CCM: WAITING FOR THE NATIONAL GUIDELINES ON ETHANOL PRODUCTION AND DISTRIBUTION IN MADAGASCAR

Due to unclear regulations in the Malagasy law concerning the production and distribution of ethanol in Madagascar, potential project investors, including those that seek to produce ethanol and those that seek to sell ethanol stoves, are reluctant to move forward with investment plans. This particularly put local companies in a disadvantage.

The latest feedback that we have received is that the Malagasy Government might publish guidelines and requirements for activities related to the production of ethanol from micro distilleries, as well as for those that might engage in distribution and sales of cooking fuel and ethanol stoves. This is a delay compared to previous indications on when such guidelines and requirements would be made available.

Clean Cooking Madagascar is still waiting for these guidelines from the Malagasy Government since the national requirements for selling denatured ethanol and ethanol CookStoves are still not clear.

FINAL SELECTION OF SITE FOR THE PILOT MICRO-DISTILLERY

Clean Cooking Madagascar has registered three best potential sites where to set up its pilot micro-distillery. These three potential sites are all located in the East coast of Madagascar.

SELECTION OF EQUIPMENT SUPPLIER FOR THE PILOT MICRO-DISTILLERY

Clean Cooking Madagascar has recently published a request for proposal to build a micro-distillery. A short list of potential suppliers has been prepared. This will be relatively high quality system, and even though the quality requirements increase the initial price, the life time cost of such systems will be lower than what would be the case for cheaper distillery solutions.
